II. Scholarship Criteria

- **A.** Applicants must have maintained a minimum grade point average of 2.5 from high school.
- **B.** Applicants must be accepted into an accredited college, university, or higher learning or technical institution.
- **C.** Applicants must submit a 500-word essay on how volunteerism or community service benefits an individual and why they believe they're a good candidate for this award.
- **D.** Awards will be sent directly to the institution for college expenses.

III. Complete Applicant Packet MUST Consist of the Following:

- ❖ Augusta Community Outreach Consortium (ACOC) Scholarship Application (included)
- **Section** Essay
 - o Must be attached with a Cover Sheet
 - Introduce Yourself
 - Tell precisely how you learned about the scholarship.
 - Provide any information you would like to highlight about yourself, your family/background
 - Essay should focus on:
 - How volunteerism or community service benefits an individual and why you believe you're a good candidate to receive this award
 - The essay format is double-spaced, two pages long, and grammatically correct, using Arial or Calibri and 12-point font.
- ❖ High Transcript (sealed envelope from a guidance counselor)
- Photograph/Picture (professional/graduation picture which may be displayed publicly if selected)
- ❖ Three letters of recommendation from the following: (3 Letters Required)
 - Pastor, Youth Pastor, or Director of any other ministry in which the student is a member
 - Teacher or any other School Official
 - Community or civic group organizational advisor

April 14, 2025
